PAPER PRESENTATION RULES

1.EACH TEAM CAN HAVE A MAXIMUM OF THREE MEMBERS, AND NO SUBSTITUTIONS ARE ALLOWED.

2.PARTICIPANTS ARE FREE TO CHOOSE THEIR OWN TOPIC AND PAPER TITLE.

3.THE PAPER MUST FOLLOW THE IEEE FORMAT, INCLUDING PROPER STRUCTURE, CITATIONS, AND REFERENCES.

4.PLAGIARISM EXCEEDING 15% WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

5.A DIGITAL COPY OF THE PRESENTATION (PPT) MUST BE SUBMITTED VIA THE PROVIDED LINK BEFORE THE DEADLINE.

6.THE PRESENTATION HAS A STRICT TIME LIMIT OF TEN MINUTES, FOLLOWED BY A FIVE-MINUTE Q&A SESSION.

7.EACH TEAM MUST BRING TWO PRINTED COPIES OF THE PAPER FOR THE JUDGES.

PAPER PRESENTATION RULES

8.THE PRESENTATION SLIDES MUST COVER THE PROBLEM, METHODOLOGY, RESULTS, AND INNOVATION.

9.THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF SLIDES ALLOWED IS 12, AND THEY MUST BE CLEAR AND CONCISE.

10.THE JUDGING CRITERIA CONSIST OF 100 POINTS, DISTRIBUTED AS FOLLOWS: 30 POINTS FOR TECHNICAL DEPTH, 25 POINTS FOR INNOVATION, 20 POINTS FOR PRESENTATION SKILLS, 15 POINTS FOR Q&A PERFORMANCE, AND 10 POINTS FOR FORMAT COMPLIANCE.

11.PARTICIPANTS MUST MAINTAIN RESPECTFUL BEHAVIOR, AND ANY OFFENSIVE OR DISRESPECTFUL CONDUCT IS NOT ALLOWED.

12.CHEATING, INCLUDING THE USE OF FAKE DATA OR PRE-SCRIPTED Q&A RESPONSES, WILL RESULT IN DISQUALIFICATION.

13.THE RECOMMENDED DRESS CODE IS FORMAL OR SEMI-FORMAL ATTIRE.

14.DISQUALIFICATION WILL OCCUR IN CASES OF LATE SUBMISSIONS, PLAGIARISM, OR ANY RULE VIOLATIONS RELATED TO TIME LIMITS, FORMAT, OR MISCONDUCT.
